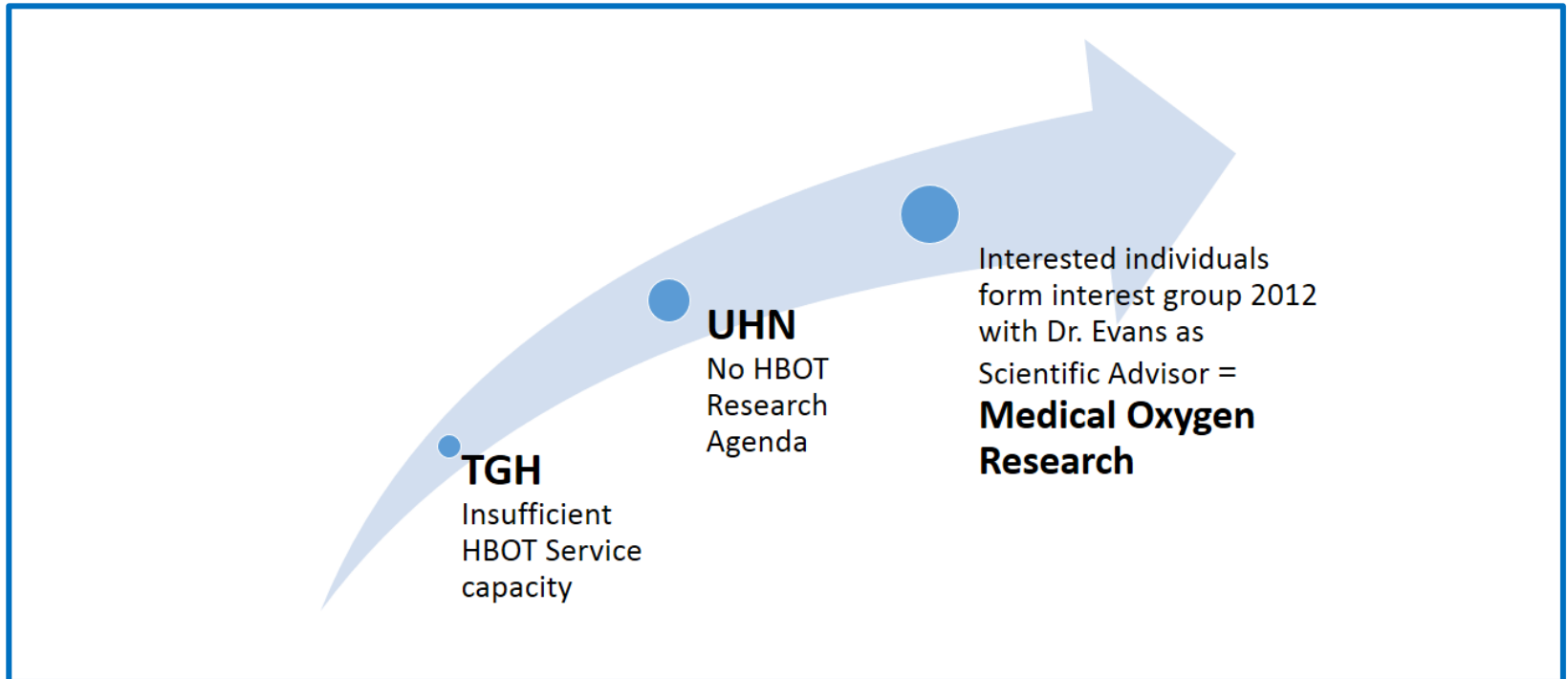

- Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada Certification - specifies Hyperbaric Medicine training in Canada

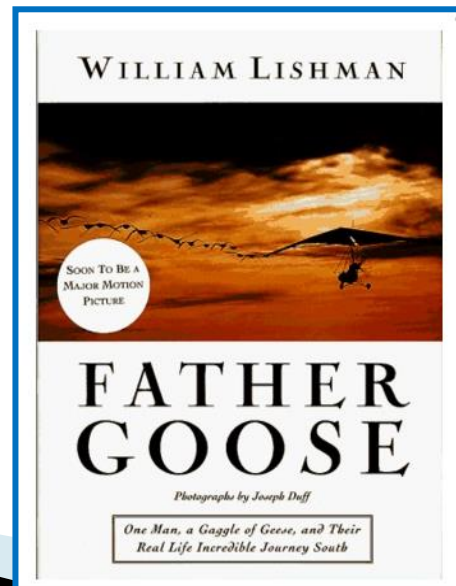


Research**

MO2R Care Model

- ▶ Comprehensive Care
 - Wound Management
 - Focus on Mobility Aids and protection of critical at-risk tissue
- ▶ Group Learning Environment
 - Effective
 - Versatile
 - Patient engagement - social aspects
 - Significant care provider exposure

MO2R Education

- ▶ Resource Center
 - Health Literacy resources available to explore topics of interest in more detail.
- ▶ Patient Engagement
 - Reminders of routine healthcare & health maintenance needs
 - Shared experiences with others facilitates exposure to new concepts and courage in self education
 - Multidisciplinary team presents a range of views which facilitates various learning styles
